

## Creative tip FIMO soft „Flower greeting card“



### Material:

FIMO SOFT in the colours plum (63), cream-grape (605) and cream-aqua (305). You can use a smooth ceramic tile, sheet of glass or transparent sleeves as a work surface.

You will also need one flower-shaped pastry cutter approx. 8 cm Ø and one circular-shaped cutter approx. 2.5 cm Ø, 1 rubber roller, 3 folded cards DIN A6 in matching colours, approx. 1 m white organza ribbon and a craft knife.



Roll each FIMO colour out on the work surface to an approx. 5 mm thick sheet. Cut out a large flower using the flower-shaped cutter. Using the circular-shaped cutter, cut a hole out of the middle of the flower. It makes sense to make more than one flower at a time! Next, place the FIMO flowers on a piece of foil on a baking tray and harden for 30 minutes at 130°C on the middle shelf of a pre-heated oven. Then take out and leave to cool. For each flower, pick a card in a matching colour and cut two small holes in the front using the craft knife so that you can attach your FIMO flower to the card with a piece of organza ribbon. That's it!
